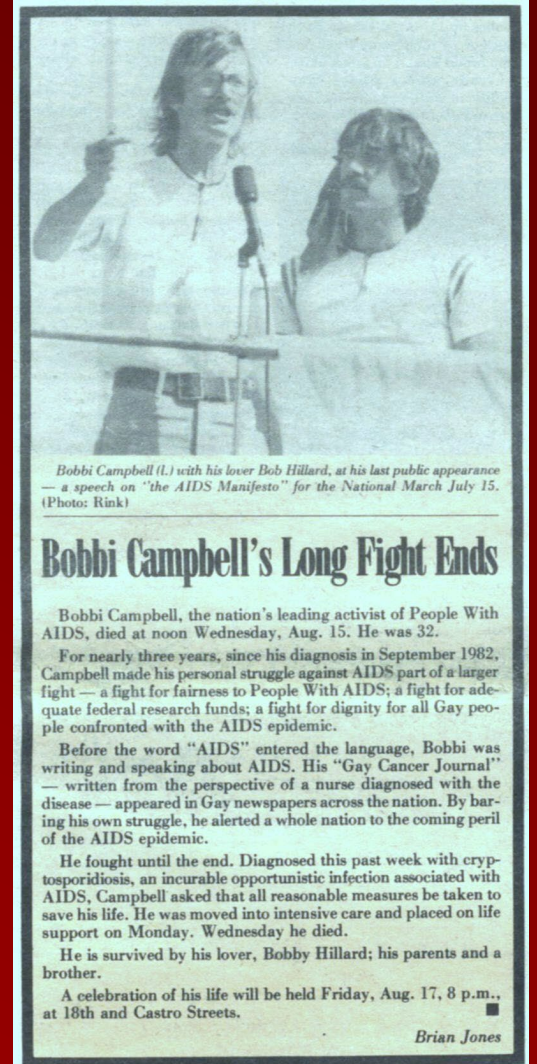
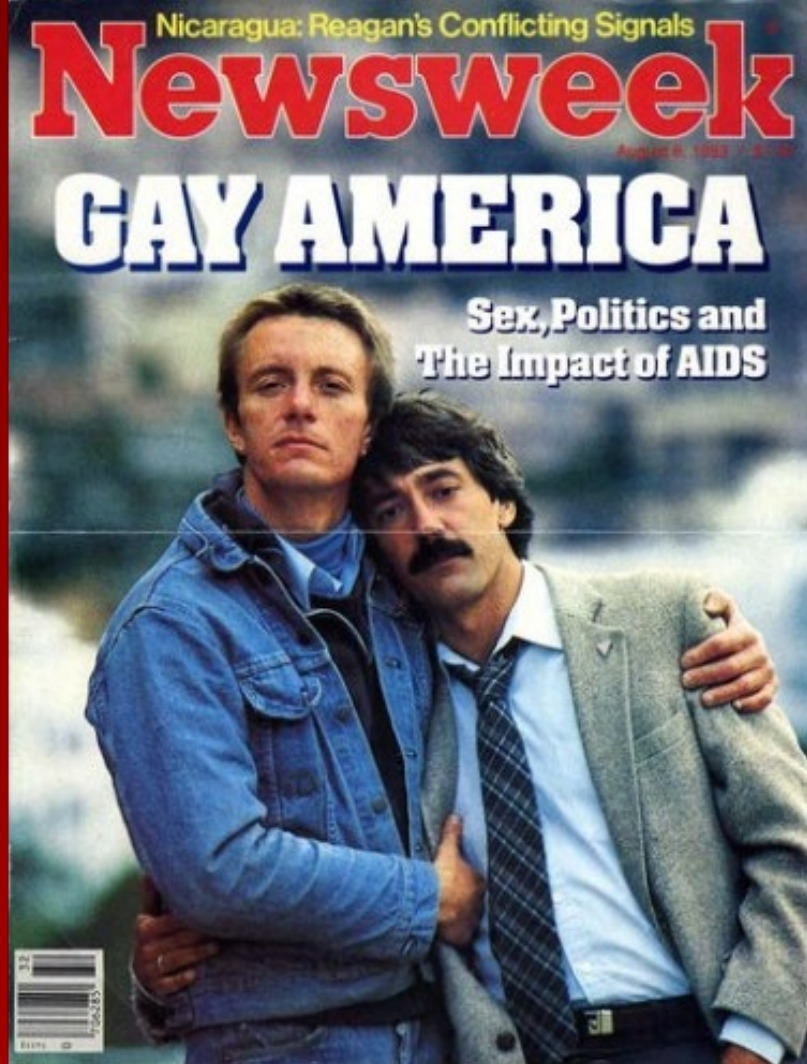


## THIS MONTH IN HISTORY

August 8, 1983: AIDS activist, public health nurse, and PWH Bobbi Campbell appears with his partner, Bobby Hilliard, on the cover of Newsweek magazine for the story, "Gay America: Sex, Politics, and the Impact of AIDS." It is the first time two gay men are pictured embracing one another on the cover of a U.S. mainstream national magazine.

August 15, 1984: Bobbi Campbell passes away at the age of 32 from opportunistic infection cryptosporidiosis.

## RW Check-In Food Bank Services



- Food Rights & Responsibilities and Card Distribution form required for all disbursed Ryan White food cards as of July 1
- Cards must be fully expended before distributing the next card
- If screening shows client is potentially eligible for SNAP, an application must be submitted and uploaded to CW
- Checkbox for “Ineligible” = denied

## **Eligibility Documentation**

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- Coming up on November 1 (supposed to be the first opportunity to complete a self-attestation recertification)
- **Many profiles do not have the correct documentation to allow for a self-attestation**
  - What have been the barriers to collecting all required documentation?
  - What have been the barriers to checking your client profiles to ensure you have all the required documentation?

# Durable Medical Equipment (DME)



- \$750 limit per RW-eligible client per contract year
- Items must be medically necessary and ordered by a physician
  - Glasses with basic lenses & frames – no thinning, no tinting, no progressive (two-year limit)
  - Diabetic supplies
  - Other supplies as covered by Medicare guidelines for necessity (available [online](#))
- Insurance must pay first (Part B can cover co-pay)
- Providers should have a policy to ensure the DME is obtained at the lowest possible cost
