

Unmet Need Technical Notes

Definitions retrieved from 2023 epidemiology profile.

- **Persons with HIV (PWH)** is defined as the number of persons living with an HIV diagnosis in this area at the end of each respective calendar year, as of 6/30/2024. HIV diagnoses include persons whose HIV diagnosis occurred in the period specified, data as of 6/30/2024.
- **In Care:** PWH with at least one documented VL or CD4 lab, medical visit, or prescription from 1/1/2023 through 3/31/2024, data as of 6/30/2024.
- **Out of Care:** PWH with no documented VL or CD4 lab, medical visit, or prescription from 1/1/2023 through 3/31/2024, data as of 6/30/2024.
- **Retained in Care:** PWH with two or more documented VL or CD4 labs, medical visits, or prescriptions at least three months apart from 1/1/2023 through 6/30/2024, data as of 6/30/2024. **Suppressed Viral Load:** PWH with a suppressed VL (<200 copies/mL) on the last VL from 1/1/2023 through 3/31/2024, data as of 6/30/2024.
- **In Care with Suppressed Viral Load:** PWH with at least one documented VL or CD4 lab, medical visit, or prescription from 1/1/2023 through 3/31/2024 that also has a suppressed VL (<200 copies/mL) on the last VL from 1/1/2023 through 3/31/2024, data as of 6/30/2024.
- **Retained in Care with Suppressed Viral Load:** PWH with two or more documented VL or CD4 labs, medical visits, or prescriptions at least three months apart from 1/1/2023 through 6/30/2024 that also has a suppressed VL (<200 copies/mL) on the last VL from 1/1/2023 through 3/31/2024, data as of 6/30/2024.
- **No Viral Load:** No documented VL lab from 1/1/2023 through 3/31/2024, data as of 6/30/2024.
- **Late Diagnosis:** AIDS diagnosis within 3 months of HIV diagnosis.
