#### What is VITA?

- National IRS Program
- Free tax preparation service run by certified volunteers
- In-person and virtual
- Orange, Osceola and Seminole counties
- Earn moderate income or less (household income of \$73,000 or less)
- Senior citizen, ESL, Disabled





# What to Expect at a VITA Site

#### 3 Volunteer Types

- Greeter
- Tax Preparer
- \*Quality Reviewer Ensures every taxpayer receives top quality service; ensures tax returns are error-free; tax law certified\*

#### Documents to bring to site:

- Social security card or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number for you, your spouse, and any children born before prior to the end of last year
- Copy of last year's tax return, if available
- Income documentation (Form W-2, W-2G, 1099-R,1099-Misc)
- Bank account information, if available
- Forms 1095 A,B, and C Health Coverage Statement, if applicable

# What is MyFreeTaxes?



- MyFreeTaxes is:
  - The <u>only</u> free, national, online tax filing program
  - An online self-service tax software provided by United Way Worldwide
  - Accessible from computer, tablet or smart phone.
- Most filers complete their taxes in less than an hour
- Can be used for any returns that are out of scope for VITA, like:
  - K1s business losses/gains
  - Rental income like AirBnB

Taxes 101





### **Common Tax Terms**

- Adjusted Gross Income (AGI): Income that has been reduced by certain amounts, such as student loan interest or IRA contributions
- Tax Liability: The amount of tax that must be paid
  - 2024 Tax Brackets and Federal Income Tax Rates | Tax Foundation
- Standard Deduction: Reduces income subject to tax and varies based on filing status, age, blindness, and dependency.
  - \$14,600 for single
  - \$29,200 for married filing jointly
  - \$21,900 for head of household
- Itemized Deduction: Expenses that can be deducted from your AGI to lower your tax bill.
  - Eligible expenses include things like medical expenses, interest paid, and charitable donations





#### **Common Tax Terms**

- Tax Credits: A dollar-for-dollar reduction in tax. Can be deducted directly from taxes owed.
- Non-refundable Credits: When the credit is more than taxes owed, the taxpayer can only have their taxes reduced to zero. They <u>cannot</u> get a "refund" on unused credit.
  - The Child Tax Credit, Lifetime Learning Credit
- Refundable Credits: When a credit is more than taxes owed, taxpayers can get a "refund" for some of the unused credit.
  - Some examples of refundable credits include: Earned Income Tax Credit, American Opportunity Credit





# Who is Eligible for the EITC?

- The EITC stands for the Earned Income Tax Credit
  - It is a refundable tax credit.
- Basic Rules:
  - Have worked and earned income under \$63,398
  - Have investment income below \$11,000
  - Have a Social Security Number
  - Be a U.S. citizen or resident alien all year
  - Do not have Foreign Earned Income (filed on Form 2555)





#### **EITC Fast Facts**

- Maximum Credit Amounts:
  - Up to \$632 No qualifying children
  - Up to \$7,830 Three or more qualifying children
- Income Limits:
  - If Single:
    - No qualifying children \$18,591
    - 3 or more qualifying children \$59,899
  - If Married:
    - No qualifying children \$25,511
    - 3 or more qualifying children \$66,819





#### IRS Resources

- To check eligibility of credits:
  - Use the EITC Assistant | Internal Revenue Service (irs.gov) Interactive Tax Assistant, answers common tax questions and can evaluate whether you qualify for certain credits (EITC, CTC, Education Credits)
- Comparison of Education Credits:
  - compare education credits | Earned Income Tax Credit (irs.gov) IRS Chart that compares the LLC and AOTC credits so you can decide which is the best for you.




