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AIDS Drug Assistance Program

ADAP is a statewide, federally funded prescription medication program for qualifying people living with HIV.

This program provides access to medications to eligible clients either directly or by purchase of health insurance that includes coverage for HIV medications.





- 1. You must be determined eligible to receive HIV patient care services through the patient care <u>eligibility</u> screening process
- 2. Have income at 400% or less of the federal poverty level
- 3. Visit <u>ADAP enrollment page</u>
- 4. Call your local <u>county health department</u> and speak with an ADAP staff member
- 5. Enroll in ADAP
- 6. Get your prescriptions filled



ADAP Online Recertification

- Clients can enroll or recertify for ADAP services online
- Convenient and secure method of enrollment or recertification
- ADAP policy requires each clients to re-enroll every 12 months to remain active in the ADAP program

ADAP Enrollment Requirements

- Patient Care Core Eligibility Form
- Prescription for at least one antiretroviral
- Insurance documentation, if applicable review ADAP Insurance tab for more information on insurance



Geting Prescription Filled

- Uninsured clients at a county health department with no on-site pharmacy will be served through a specialty pharmacy - visit <u>specialty pharmacy</u> <u>services</u>
- Clients with insurance will pick-up medications from a CVS retail store or <u>participating pharmacy</u>



ADAP – Federal Marketplace Insurance

ADAP clients with income of at least 50% of the federal poverty level may qualify for assistance with insurance through the federal marketplace.

- Be enrolled in an ADAP supported insurance plan
- Use a pharmacy in the network of the ADAP contracted pharmacy benefits manager to receive medication co-payments and/or deductible assistance
- Use ADAP contracted insurance benefits manager to enroll in and receive premium assistance with insurance



ADAP – Federal Marketplace Insurance

- Request determination of available subsidies from the marketplace when submitting an application
- Provide all supporting documentation required by the federal marketplace at the time the application is submitted and enrollment is processed

ADAP Insurance Assistance

- Medicaid Share-of-Cost, if the cost of medications is not enough to activate share-of-cost Medicaid each month
- Medicare Part C or Part D, co-pays only
- Employer-sponsored insurance
- COBRA policies



ADAP Insurance Assistance

- Annually approved ADAP supported plans in the federal marketplace
- ADAP cannot pay for a stand-alone dental or vision insurance policies
- ADAP cannot pay out-of-pocket costs for any service except pharmacy costs, however <u>other DOH HIV program</u> may be able to help



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
