<p>New Business:</p>	<p>Intersectionality Between HIV & Nutrition</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nutritionist Ms. Alvarado provided a presentation on the intersectionality between nutrition and HIV, including common challenges that PWH may face in managing nutrition. • She explained the definition of intersectionality and discussed the potential biological, social, and psychological impacts that nutrition has on the body. • She recommended resources for managing healthier eating habits, such as myplate.gov and community resources like Second Harvest Food Bank, United Way of Lake County, Lake Care, Inc., and more. • She also provided suggestions for healthier alternatives, how to reduce food waste and

	save money, and strategies for building sustainable nutrition habits.
