<p>New Business:</p>	<p>Substance Abuse Outpatient Service Standards:</p> <p>Whitney Marshall discussed the purpose of the Service Standards and explained the process for which they are approved and updated, which includes getting community feedback. The participants were given the chance to review the Service Standards for Substance Abuse Outpatient Care and did not have any recommendations for changes.</p> <p>Hurricane Response and Preparation:</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • QLatinx invited members of the public to share their experiences from the recent hurricane. Members of the public discussed difficulties faced by homeless members of the community during storm preparation, as well as issues with finding shelter for pets, loneliness, and lack of psychosocial support during the hurricane. • QLatinx presented information on the disproportionate impacts faced by LGBTQIA+ Latinx communities when storms come through. • QLatinx presented how they help the community prepare and respond to hurricanes, including meal deliveries, informational resources, charging stations, home renovations, and clothing support. • QLatinx also shared various community initiatives they have facilitated in Central Florida, as well as a recent event held in Puerto Rico. • Angie Buckley (Aspire Health Partners) discussed strategies to support mental health after a natural disaster; strategies included limiting TV time, making a schedule for when to check the news in order to avoid information overload, and maintaining your sleep schedule. • QLatinx made announcements about the following upcoming events: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Queer Volunteer Pre-Pride Pizza Party – October 17th @ 5pm ○ Unidos en Pride during Come Out With Pride Saturday October 19th ○ Trunk or Treat October 25th
