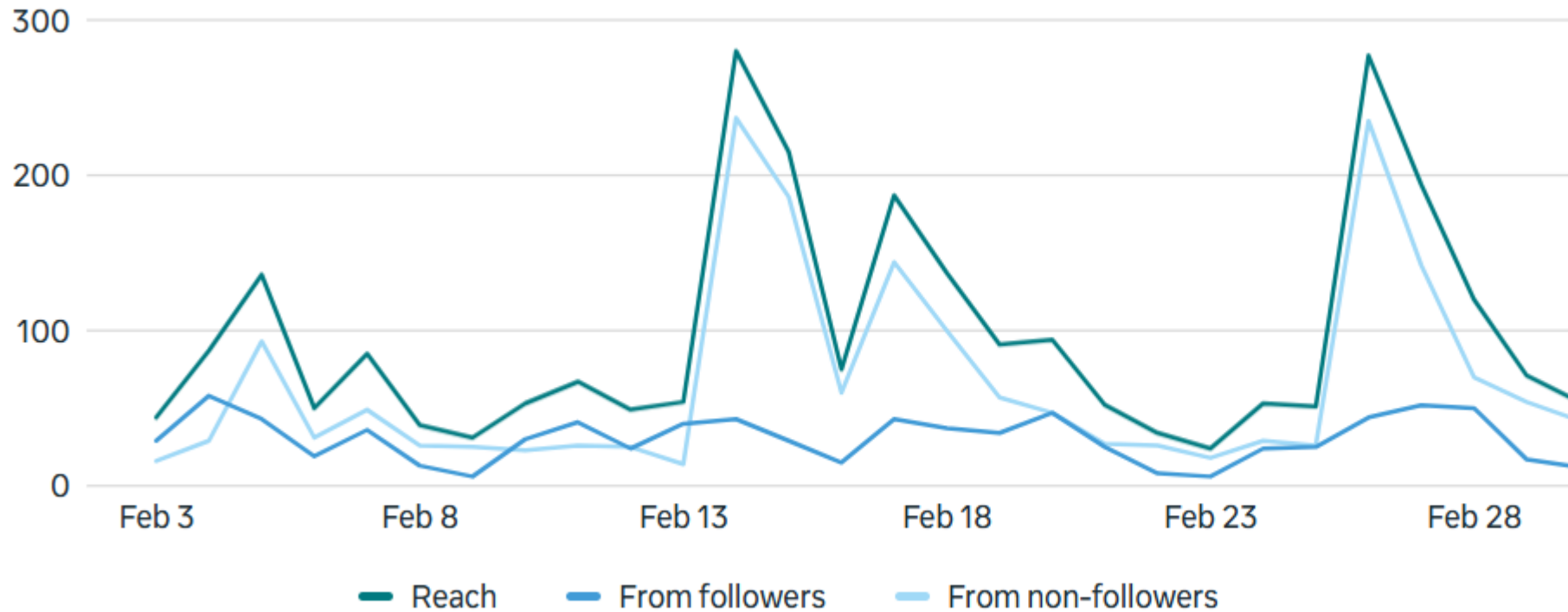



What is a SERODIFFERENT relationship?

A relationship is serodifferent (or serodiscordant) if one person is HIV-positive and the other person is HIV-negative.

Ways to reduce the chance of transmission:

- Antiretroviral therapy (ART)
- Achieving and maintaining an undetectable viral load
- Condom use
- Pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP)
- Routine HIV testing

Open, honest communication is a must!

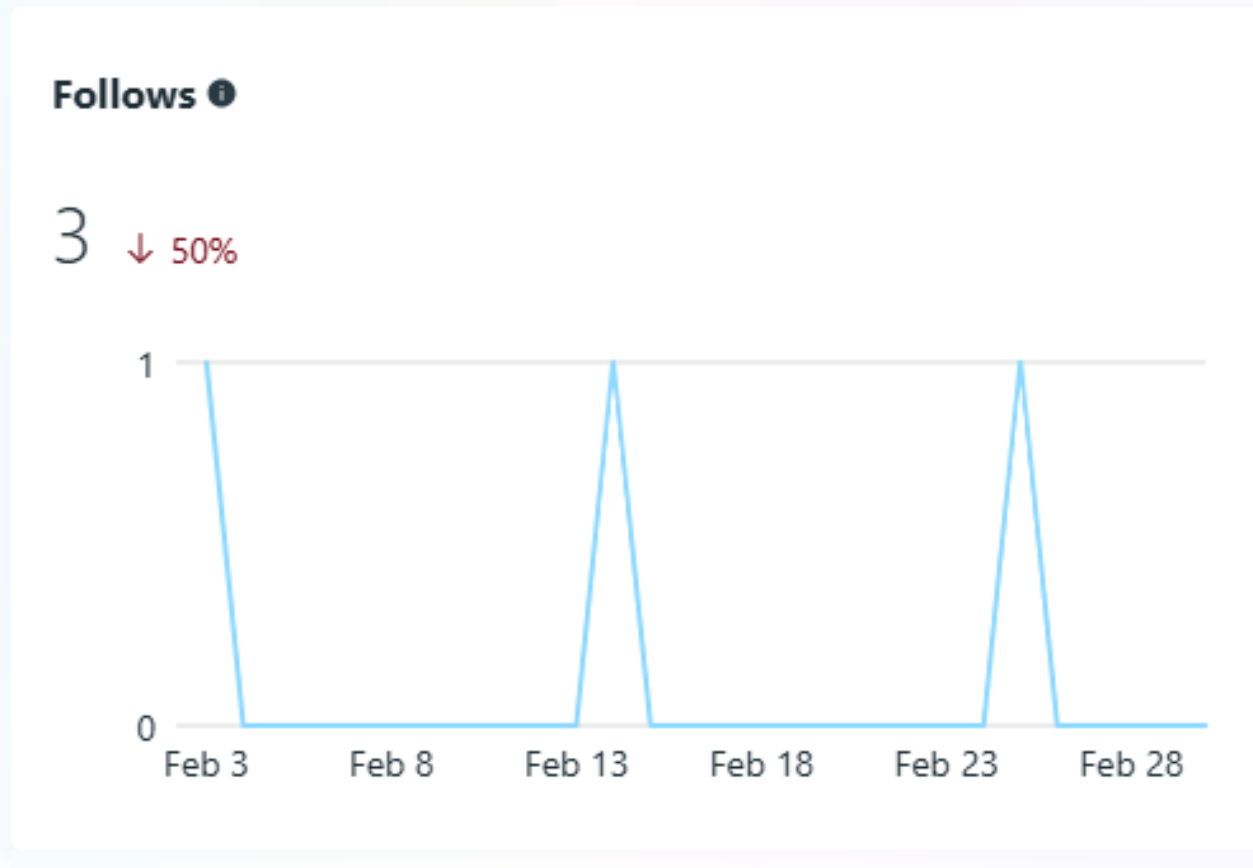

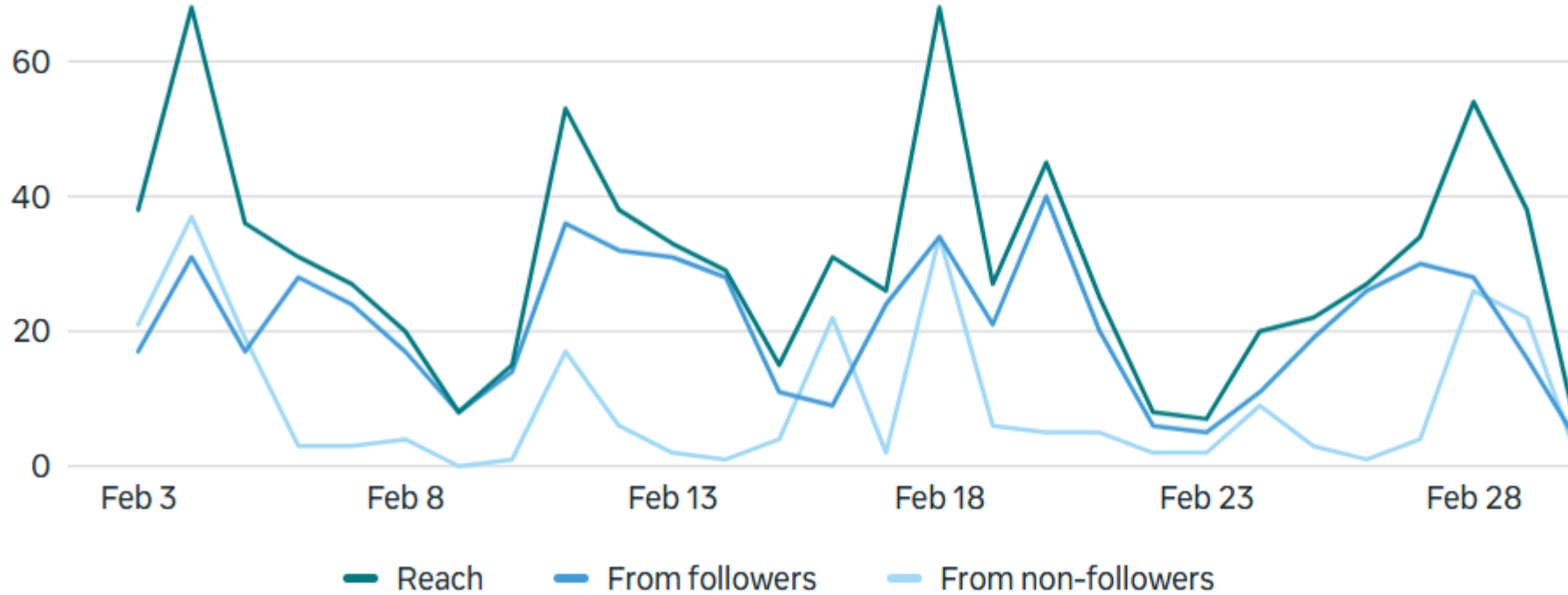

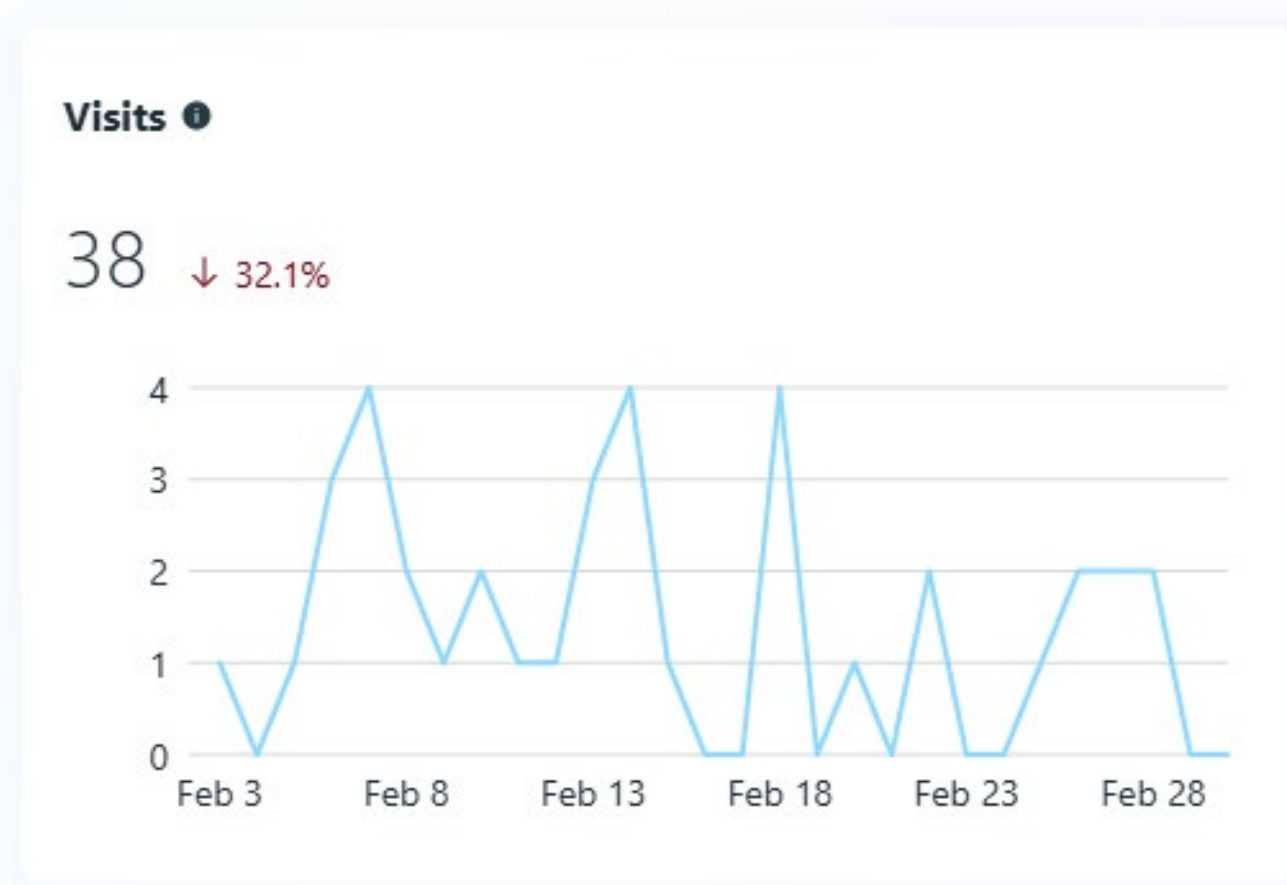
