



CFHPC Applicant Summary

Candidate #2025-16: This candidate is a White male currently in the 40-49 age group who is interested in joining the Planning Council as Full Member in order to bring his life experience to the Planning Council. The candidate brings experience in volunteering in the community, having participated in fundraising events for the HIV and LGBTQ+ community. In the candidate's view, the greatest challenge that people with HIV experience is a lack of knowledge about resources available to them. The candidate is enthusiastic about bringing his perspective to the Planning Council.

Candidate's Requested Committee: Membership & Engagement

Interview Update: Candidate #2025-16 received an average score of 25 out of 40 across all competencies that were evaluated by the three interviewers. The candidate demonstrated an understanding of the importance of weighing pros and cons before making difficult decisions, as well as the importance of taking criticism constructively. The candidate expressed his priority of ensuring that everyone with HIV knows what resources are available to them, particularly individuals who have formerly been incarcerated. The candidate appears highly motivated to join the Planning Council and wishes to help close the gap in community awareness. The candidate indicated a preference for the Membership & Engagement committee. The candidate would not increase the Planning Council's perceived conflicts and was unanimously recommended by all interviewers.

Committee Update: After review of the Membership Matrix, the Membership & Engagement Committee recommended that the candidate be forwarded to the Executive Committee with a recommendation to be assigned to the Membership & Engagement Committee.

Next Steps: If recommended for appointment by the Executive Committee, the candidate will move forward to the full Planning Council for review and a vote.
